

TUITION SUPPRESSION POLICY and PROCEDURE
FOR GRADUATING CLASS of 2019
Chicago, Rockford, Peoria, and Urbana
Effective November 1, 2018

The purpose of this policy is to address the satisfactory completion of any remaining clinical requirements for an M4 student who is eligible to graduate in spring (May) with the MD degree.

An M4 student who is scheduled to meet all requirements for spring graduation but needs to be enrolled in a partial summer term to do so, may have tuition for summer term waived by the College at its discretion, provided that:

1. *The student is eligible for May graduation according to the stated graduation policy in section VIII.E, of the University of Illinois College of Medicine Student Academic Policies and Professional Standards.*
2. *The student does not need to complete more than 2 clinical requirements.*
3. *The student can successfully complete remaining clinical requirements between April 29, 2019 and June 22, 2019 of the summer term.*
4. *A student utilizing tuition suppression to complete a clinical requirement for a Spring 2019 degree is not eligible for summer financial aid disbursement.*

The College will proceed as follows:

1. *The campus registrar will produce a proposed list of students in this situation and, the rotation(s) scheduled for meeting graduation requirements.*
2. *The campus registrar will submit the information to the campus student affairs/academic affairs office for review, leading to a discussion with each student on the list regarding, their need to pay assessments and fees based on eligibility for access to services and facilities, and approval.*
3. *The campus student affairs/ academic affairs office will return the approved list to campus registrar.*
4. *The campus registrar will forward the reviewed and approved list to the College of Medicine Registrar.*
5. *The College of Medicine Registrar's office and the UIC Office of the Registrar will process the registration of each approved student.*

If the student is unable to complete the remaining clinical requirements by June 22, 2019, the student will be responsible for paying tuition and assessments/fees in the summer term of the M4 year and will not be considered a spring (May) graduate. The fees below are applicable to students completing requirements by June 22, 2019.
