Annual report 2020-2021

University of Illinois College of Medicine will undergo review by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education in 2022, thus a great deal of effort is underway by staff to prepare the necessary documentation for this recurring review.

The 2020-21 year occurred in the midst of the Covid pandemic, as did all other world-wide activities. This caused CME programs to either cancel or develop virtual materials that were delivered live via the internet (e.g. Zoom or Webex). Many were also recorded for asynchronous viewing.

Despite the effects of the pandemic on CME programming, the College of Medicine has expanded its work with the College of Pharmacy to develop and support online CME programs. The Committee has continued to collaborate with the College of Pharmacy on a shared CME website for posting and advertising activities that include enduring and online activities. Currently, access to six different ongoing College of Medicine departmental CME Grand Rounds, College of Pharmacy online programs and other similar programming can be accessed via this site. This website continues to develop and can be accessed at <https://cemedicine.uic.edu>.

During the course of the 2020-2021 year, the Chicago, Peoria and Urbana campuses had CME certified for 90 activities for a total of 2494.5 AMA PRA Category 1 credit hours of instruction. Of these, 45 were RSS activities and 45 were episodic programs.
