College Committee on Clinical and Adjunct Appointments and Promotions Annual Report 2021-2022

The Committee on Clinical and Adjunct Appointments and Promotions is responsible for reviewing recommendations for appointment and promotion of non-salaried faculty in the Clinical and Adjunct Tracks. The Committee also makes recommendations concerning the College criteria for appointments and promotions in these tracks and the form by which these recommendations are forwarded to the Dean.

Appointment and promotion to advanced rank in the Clinical Track depends upon patient care and stature in the practice of medicine, and/or teaching excellence, with some demonstration of scholarly activity expected. Appointment and promotion in the Adjunct Track is largely based on the level of professional development achieved by the individual in his or her own field or external position.

This year, a total of 17 recommendations for appointments and promotions in the clinical and adjunct tracks were reviewed by the Committee. A breakdown of the Committee's actions is as follows:
