Chicago Committee on Committees Annual Report 2021-2022

The Committee on Committees is charged with developing slates of candidates for election to the standing committees of the College of Medicine at Chicago and Chicago representatives to College committees. In addition, the Committee advises the Dean on the appointment of faculty to fill mid-term vacancies on standing committees and periodically reviews the size and composition of Chicago committees.

In July, the Committee slated candidates for the Chicago and College-level standing committees, and prepared the ballot for Chicago representatives to the College Executive Committee. In slating the Chicago and College standing committees, the Committee selected candidates based on recommendations from committee chairs, department heads, and administrators; balanced representation of departments; faculty interest forms; and diversity of membership. Committee interest forms were again collected from the faculty using a Qualtrics survey, which significantly increases the Committee's ability to align committee needs with the faculty's interest in service.

The Committee continues to review and discuss various ways to improve diversity in committee membership as well as ways to encourage robust faculty participation and expand representation.
